Objectives:

Topic:

Task:

 - Keep track of all resources and include a slide citing sources.
 - Do NOT use Wikipedia!
- Create an AMAZING PowerPoint document to include the following.
 - Follow an outline with an introduction, presentation of both sides, and a solid conclusion.
 - At least 1 table or chart
 - Graphics
 - Make them interesting but also relevant.
 - Multimedia, sounds and/or videos
 - Effective slide layouts and designs
 - Appropriate animations and transitions
 - Use correct spelling, grammar, and punctuation.
 - Add forward & back action buttons to all slides.
- Ensure that the PowerPoint follows the guidelines to include an effective presentation.

- Prepare for a presentation that will be given to a group of classmates.
 - Write out detailed delivery lines in the notes.
 - The presentation will be 4-6 minutes.
