

Steps To Battleship

1. Download “Battleship Board” from my website
2. Save As “Period_LastName_FirstName_Battleship”
3. Highlight the Range A1:K2 and click on the “Merge & Center” Button
4. Type in the Words “My Battleship Board (Boats)”
5. Click off of the Cells you just created, and then click back onto the merged cells
6. Add the Color, “Blue Accent 1” by clicking on the Paint Bucket
7. Change the Font Color to White
8. Change the Size to 20 and Bold
9. Click the Center Alignment Button
10. Click the Middle Alignment Button
11. Highlight the Range A4:A13 and click on the Border Box, All Borders
12. Click off of the boxes you just made a border around
13. Number the Boxes from 1 to 10 starting in cell A4 down to A13
14. Highlight the Range A4:A13
15. Click on the Center Alignment Button
16. Click on the Middle Alignment Button
17. Click on the Bold Button
18. Highlight the Range B4:K4 and click on the Border Box, All Borders
19. Starting in cell B4, Name the boxes A-J (Left to Right)
20. Select the Range B4:K4 and Center Align the Cells, Middle Align the Range and Bold the Range
21. Highlight the Range B5:K13 and select Borders all Borders
22. Select the Range M1:W2 and Merge & Center the cells
23. Type in the words “My Playing Board (Ships I’m Trying to Sink)”
24. Fill in the range with a Red Color, White Font Color, Size 20, Bold
25. Highlight the Range A4:K13 and Copy the table (ctrl+C)
26. Select cell M4 and Paste the table (ctrl+V)
27. If your table is highlighted still with dancing ants, double click inside of the table on the left and it should go away
28. Add your ships to the “My Battleship Board (Boats)” by highlighting the appropriate number of boxes for the size of ship and color them Gray (Select the number of boxes and use the fill button)—You have 5 ships of different sizes to fill on your board
29. When it is your turn, Fill in the boxes, Red for a Hit, Blue for a miss
30. Drop your Battleship Board to Me (It’s okay if you don’t finish the game)
